SUNDAY SERVICE, June 10, at 10:00 AM – “Music Sunday”

The UUFF Choir, directed by Frederick Johnson and accompanied by Nancy Wendlandt, will present the annual “Music Sunday,” a service with anthems, hymns, rounds, solos, duets and a performance by the Youth Jazz Ensemble. All of the music will be a reflection on the Seven Principles of the Unitarian Universalist Association, which will be read and explained by choir members. These principles are a guide for a “living tradition” of wisdom and spirituality. Music Sunday is a very special event at UUFF as it emphasizes the profound importance that music plays in our spiritual journey.



SHARE THE PLATE, Sunday, June 10 - This month the Share the Plate recipient is Thrive also known as CIGSYA (the Cape & Islands Gay & Straight Youth Alliance). CIGSYA is a community-based alliance of young people from fourteen to twenty-two that exists to improve the lives of LGBTIQQS (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex, queer, questioning and straight) youth on Cape Cod and the Islands. The organization addresses key risk factors such as the self-hate, isolation, and fear that are often prevalent in their lives. CIGSYA works toward eliminating all forms of discrimination based on differences through education and training, and by providing a space where young people come together in an environment of respect, free from judgment and harassment. CIGSYA’s programs involve youth leadership in decision-making, program design, and implementation. Please give generously.
