The 66th UU Falmouth Annual Business meeting was held on Sunday, June 8, 2025. Members who attended, in person and via Zoom, voted to accept the slate of nominees for the Governing Board, the Committee on Ministry, and the Nominating Committee; the proposed FY2026 budget; AND **unanimously**



voted to call Rev. Rali as our full-time settled minister!

Rali will start as our full-time minister in September but will continue her interim schedule through August. Her days at UU Falmouth: June 13, 14, 15, 16 and 27, 28, 29, 30; July 18, 19, 20, 21 and 25, 26, 27, 28; August 1, 2, 3, 4, and 8, 9, 10, 11.
