3. Stand in Solidarity with the Wampanoag Tribe

- a. Support tribal health, education, and social service efforts.
- b. Financially support for the Wôpanâak Language Reclamation Project.
- c. Support ongoing Federal court litigation and/or pending Federal legislation to confirm the trust status of tribal land.
- d. Inform the congregation about "Rights of Nature" to protect herring in the Wampanoags' traditional homelands.

4. Support Upper Cape Housing Security

- a. Inform the congregation about housing insecurity on the Upper Cape.
- b. Encourage donations and volunteerism for programs serving the unhoused population.
- c. Support affordable/attainable housing opportunities.
